The California English Language Development Test (CELDT) 2016–17 Edition *Guide to Test Reports* is available for download from the [Test Interpretation Guides](#) Web page of the CELDT Web site. It may be printed and provided to district staff and parents and/or guardians.

The purpose of the guide is to help parents and others understand the *CELDT Student Performance Level Report*. The guide provides the purposes of the CELDT, describes the test format, includes a sample of the *2016–17 Edition CELDT Student Performance Level Report*, and indicates where more information can be obtained. The guide is applicable to all grades.

Additionally, a second document called the *CELDT Test Performance Descriptors* is also available on the same Web page provided above. This document, which has not been modified from the previous edition, includes the Overall Test Performance Descriptors—one set for students in kindergarten and grade one (K–1), and another for students in grades two through twelve; and domain-specific descriptors for each grade/grade span (K–1, 2, 3–5, 6–8, and 9–12).

The 2016–17 Edition *Guide to Test Reports* and the *CELDT Test Performance Descriptors* documents are available in English, Spanish, Vietnamese, and Chinese (traditional).
