2016–17 Edition Data Review Module (DRM) Opens

The DRM provides an opportunity for districts to view and correct errors in data for tests administered during the Annual Assessment (AA) Window. To review and correct data, log on to the secure [District Portal](#) and select the *Data Review Module* link. The 2016–17 Edition DRM will stay open until 5:00 p.m. on **Friday, March 24, 2017**.

Last Day to Request a Pickup of Scorable Materials for February

To schedule a request for pickup for 2016–17 Edition scorable materials, log on to the secure [District Portal](#) and select the *Request a Pickup* link.

Did You Know?

- Changes made in the DRM may affect the calculation of the English Learner Indicator in the state's new accountability system and will impact the district's AA summary reports. The descriptions and correction suggestions for the Statewide Student Identifier (SSID) field errors and warnings in the DRM have changed for the 2016–17 Edition. Refer to the *2016–17 CELDT Edition DRM Opens February 27 E-mail*, to be sent on February 10, 2017, for more information on how to work with your California Longitudinal Pupil Achievement Data System (CALPADS) administrator to make all corrections.
- After the DRM closes at 5:00 p.m. on **Friday, March 24, 2017**, the CELDT Student Score File (SSF) data will be merged with the CALPADS data if the SSF record matches with the CALPADS record.
- The 2017–18 Edition Initial Ordering Window opens **Monday, March 13, 2017**. Because in the 2017–18 Edition districts will only test Initial Assessment (IA) students, the Initial Ordering system will be populated with the number of IA students tested by grade during the 2016–17 Edition July through October months. Districts should look at demographic trends to ensure that this estimate will be enough materials to test students in the first few months of the 2017–18 Edition. As always, districts will be able to place one Additional Order each month throughout the edition should more materials be needed.
